UPTOWN WATERLOO GREAT OKTOBERFEST BARREL RACE RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. Participating teams can be men's, ladies' or co-ed (co-ed teams must have two women and two men) and must have four rollers per team.
- 2. Registration is at 10:30 a.m. on Saturday, October 14. You may pre-register through the UpTown Waterloo BIA Office at a cost of \$35 (until Tuesday, October 10) or at the above date and time for \$40. Registration closes once the races begin at approximately 11am.
- 3. Times will be recorded in seconds up to a 100th of a second.
- 4. Initially, each team will have two rolls, one in each lane, and the times will be added for a total time. The lowest total times will move on to the next round. The number of teams moving on to the semi-finals will depend on the number of teams registered in each category.
- 5. Teams moving on to the semi-finals will compete in the following manner: 1st seed vs. 4th seed and 2nd seed vs. 3rd seed. Again each team will race twice and the times will be totaled. The winner of each heat will race each other in the finals.
- 6. The finals will again be two races and the team with the lowest combined time total in each category wins.
